The International Summer School of Paediatric Anaesthesiology (ISSPA) in Serbia

The International Summer School of Paediatric Anaesthesiology (ISSPA) has been organized seven times so far at the University Children's Hospital, Belgrade, Serbia.

It is supported by the World Federation of Societies of Anaesthesiologists (WFSA), endorsed by the European Society of Anaesthesiologists (ESA) and the European Society for Paediatric Anaesthesiology (ESPA). Organizing and Scientific Committee is chaired by Prof. Dusica Simic.

Also, The Committee for Paediatric Anaesthesia in close collaboration with Education Committee launched Regional Training Centre for Paediatric Anaesthesia in Belgrade, for anaesthesiologists from former Yugoslavia, former SSSR, Middle East and North Africa. We are offering three modules (cardiac anaesthesia, paediatric intensive care and regional anaesthesia and pain therapy. First two months are dedicated to the basics of paediatric and neonatal anaesthesia in every module.

Foreign lecturers from Germany, Austria, Spain, United Kingdom, Poland, Australia and United States of America, Montenegro, Bosnia and Hercegovina spoke about interesting, important and up-to date topics in Neonatal and Paediatric Anaesthesia and Intensive Care. Together with foreign lecturers, more than 20 lecturers from all four Serbian centers for paediatric anaesthesia presented their work, during case based discussions and pro/ con debates on selected topics.


The aim of this meeting is to help anaesthesiologists to refresh and further develop their knowledge and skills in the field of paediatric anaesthesia, thereby enhancing the safety of children requiring their service. It also provides education for junior doctors that train in anaesthesia.

This comprehensive course strives to promote high standards in the specialty through continuous education and enable practice of safe paediatric anaesthesia in non-paediatric environment.

The course lasts for two days. Lectures are held in the morning and in the afternoon participants have the opportunity to attend workshops like difficult airway management, mechanical ventilation in children, the use of ultrasound in paediatric regional anaesthesia etc.

Simulation workshop has always been one of the most popular, highly valued and attended by great number of participants. Educational methods are: short lectures, different simulation scenarios for attendants to practice, as well as various practical procedures.

The course starts with an entry test of knowledge and completes by an exit test in the form of Multiple Choice Questions.
